

WEEE Statement

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE) applies to companies that manufacture, sell, distribute, recycle or treat electrical and electronic equipment and to consumers in the EU. It covers all large and small household appliances, IT equipment, radio and audio equipment, electrical tools and telecommunications equipment, aiming to reduce the waste arising from electrical and electronic equipment and to improve the environmental performance of all parts and processes involved in the life cycle of these products.

As distributors of electronic components, which fall outside of the scope of the directive, are not obligated to provide any schemes for the disposal of business WEEE

OEM Products produced to specific customer requirements are labelled as per the European Directive EN50419 with the “crossed out wheelie bin” symbol on product labelling.
